PET IMAGING IN PEDIATRIC EPILEPSY: CURRENT STATUS AND FUTURE PERSPECTIVES

Prof. Tian is a nuclear medicine physician-scientist by training and Distinguished Professor endowed by the Ministry of Education of China. She serves as the Vice President of Zhejiang University Medical Center. She has received innumerable international and national awards, including the Gold Medal of National Young Professionals and Women in Science Award. She also serves as the Associate Editor, Regional Editor or Editorial Board Member of the official journals of the leading organizations including MIB, JNM, and EJNMMI etc. Prof. Tian was inducted into Fellows of World Molecular Imaging Society earlier this year, so far the only female professional of this honor from Asia.

Prof. Tian's group focuses on molecular imaging of Central Nervous System (CNS) diseases & psychiatric disorders including imaging-based stem cell therapy for stroke, brain-machine interface (BMI), internet gaming disorder (IGD), post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), and big data-based smart diagnosis for AD, PD and others.
